




Replacing the Battery

up.

- 1 Press firmly the latch and pull out the battery holder.
 - 2 Remove the old battery and insert a new lithium coin battery (CR2025) into the battery holder with the positive side (+) facing

3 Install the battery holder back into its slot.







Note:


 Remove the battery from the remote control when not in use for extended periods of time to prevent possible battery leakage.


Installing Duo Cinema in Vehicle


This device is specifically designed to be mounted behind the driver and passenger seats.

1 Remove the screws to release both locking latches on the stanchion mount.




2 Position the bracket on the bars of the headrest. Fasten the screws on both locking latches to fix the bracket firmly on the bars.







- Make sure the stanchion mount of the player is installed on the RIGHT headrest.
- **3** Connect the player and the monitor with the AV/Power cable (one end of the car power cable) as shown in the following illustration.



4 Slide the mount slot of the player into the backplate of the stanchion mount fully until it clicks into place. Repeat the same procedure to install the monitor on the LEFT headrest.




5 Adjust the player/monitor to the desired viewing angle.



Note:

♦ To remove the player/monitor from the stanchion mount, pull and hold the release latch upwards and then slide the player/monitor off to disengage the connection.



Turning the Power On/Off


Use only the supplied car power cable to power on this device.

Note:

- ◆ The supplied car power cable is for 12VDC vehicles usage only. If the player is used in a 24VDC vehicle, it may cause damage that is not covered by warranty.
- ♦ Always start the vehicle engine before connecting the player to the power supply or damage could result due to electrical surges during engine start.

Turn the Power On

Plug the other end of the car power cable to the cigarette lighter socket of your vehicle. This device automatically turns on.



Note:

 If you have properly connected both player and monitor, the picture and sound of player transfer to the monitor automatically.

Turn the Power Off

Press and hold the 🕹 button for at least 2 seconds to turn this device off.



- lacktriangle You can also turn off this device by touching the lacktriangle key on the player.
- ◆ To turn off the monitor individually, simply touch its ⁽¹⁾ key.

Making Connection


This section guides you on how to insert a DVD disc and connect your Duo Cinema to an external device.

Note:


♦ Do not unplug the USB flash drive or disconnect the cable connection during the file playback.

Insert the DVD Disc

1 On the player, press the **Open** button and carefully open the disc cover.



2 Place the disc in the compartment with the label facing up. Make sure that it is completely seated in the indent.




3 Close the disc cover by gently pressing until it clicks into place.

Connect to HDMI Input Source


You can use this device to play your favorite multimedia content (videos, pictures, and music) from your portable device (i.e. smartphone or tablet).

- 1 Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI1/HDMI2 port of the player.
- 2 Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port of the portable device.
- 3. Please check your Android phone support MHL function.



Insert USB Flash Drive

You can also use this device to play your files stored in the USB flash drive. Simply plug in the USB flash drive to the USB port of the player.



Note:

 To copy your favorite multimedia files, plug in the USB flash drive into your computer USB port and transfer the files to the root directory of the USB flash drive.


Connect Headphones

Duo Cinema is equipped with built-in speakers. However, you may also use a set of headphones for personal listening. To use headphones, just plug in your headphone cable into the headphone jack of the player and/or monitor.



With the built-in IR transmitter, you can use wireless headphones. When the IR headphone is connected to the player, you can select the channel your prefer by simply pressing the $\widehat{\Omega}$ button on the remote control.

Press the (Ω) button repeatedly to toggle the IR headphones channel.



- When the headphones are connected, the speakers of Duo Cinema will be muted.
- When the IR headphones are connected, the built-in speakers are not muted. To adjust the volume level of the speakers, do the following:
 - ⇒ On the player, you can adjust the volume level by touching the \(\mathbb{I}\) or \(\mathbb{I}\)) key on the device or pressing the volume button ((\(\bar{\psi}\))) or the remote control. To mute the speakers, press the (\(\varkappi\)) button on the remote control.
- ♦ To avoid hearing damage, it is highly recommended to set the volume level to its minimum level first before plugging in the headphones.

Configuring the Settings

General Operations

Switch the Input Source

By default, this device is in DVD mode when it is turned on. To switch the input source, perform the following:

- 1 Press the 🕣 button.
- 2 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select the desired input source.
- **3** Press the (ok) button to confirm the selection.

Note:


- ♦ You can also switch the input source by touching the ₺ key on the player. Touch the ₺ key repeatedly to toggle the input source.
- ♦ If there is no signal detected, a "No Signal" message will appear on the screen.

Media Playback

Selecting File (USB input only)

Make sure you have plugged in a USB flash drive on the player.

1 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select the desired file.



- 2 Press the (ox) button to confirm the selection.
 - If a photo file is selected, the image appears in full screen.
 - If a music or video file is selected, the music/video starts playing automatically.


Using the Function Menu

To access the Function menu during playback, perform the following:

- **1** Press the 🖹 button to bring up the Function menu.
- **2** Use the (\blacktriangle) , (\blacktriangledown) , (\blacktriangledown) , or (\blacktriangleright) button to select the desired function.
- **3** Press the (ok) button to confirm the selection.
- **4** Press the (ox) button repeatedly to change the setting.

Note:


♦ The Function menu will disappear within 3 seconds if there is no operation.



Adjusting the Volume Level

To adjust the volume level, do the following:

- Press the (***) button on the remote control or touch the △**) key on the player/monitor to increase the volume level.




Adjusting the Screen Brightness

To switch the screen brightness, perform the following:


1 Press the 🕸 button to bring up the main menu.

Note:

- ♦ For HDMI input source, skip <u>Step 2</u>.
- 2 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select **Screen Menu**. Then press the ♠ button to enter **Screen Menu**.
- 3 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select Brightness. Press the ok button to confirm the selection.
- **4** Press the **④** or **▶** button to adjust the setting.



- ♦ The OSD menu will disappear within 3 seconds if there is no operation.
- ◆ To adjust the screen brightness of the monitor, simply touch its ※ or ※ key repeatedly to adjust the setting.




Configuring the Settings

DVD Menu (DVD/USB input source only)

- 1 Press the (*) button to bring up the main menu.
- 2 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select **DVD Menu**. Then press the ♠ button to enter **DVD Menu**.



3 Press the ◀ or ▶ button to select a menu category. Then press the ⊙ button to confirm.





- **4** Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select an option and then do the following:
 - Press the (ox) button to enter the submenu.

Note:

The OSD menu will disappear within 3 seconds if there is no operation.

The following menu options are available in DVD Menu:






Screen Menu

1 Press the (3) button to bring up the main menu.

Note:

- ♦ For HDMI input source, skip Step 2.
- 2 Press the ♠ or ▼ button to select Screen Menu. Then press the ⊙ button to enter Screen Menu.
- 3 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select an option and then press the ເ button to enter the submenu.
- 4 Do the following:
 - Brightness, Contrast, Hue, or Saturation: Press the or button to adjust the setting.
 - Language: Press the or

 button to select the desired setting and press the
 button to confirm.



• **Reset**: Press the (ox) button to reset all the settings.

Note:

♦ The OSD menu will disappear within 3 seconds if there is no operation.

The following menu options are available in **Screen Menu**:

Menu Option	Description
Brightness	Adjust the brightness.
Contrast	Adjust the contrast.
Hue	Adjust the hue (color).
Saturation	Adjust the saturation (color intensity).
Language	Set the on-screen display (OSD) language.
Reset	Reset all settings to the factory default settings.
